### Warm Greetings from Sunny Orchid!

OCC celebrates its 25th Silver Jubilee this year and it is a wonderful time for us to reflect on yet another milestone that we have reached. Since 1993, we have seen steady progress in the Club as we strive to make OCC exclusive for our members, yet inclusive for the Labour Movement Family. Growing through thick and thin, we have learnt a lot to become a premier Golf Country Club in Singapore that engages our members in golfing events and social & recreational activities, while fine tuning our operating processes and service delivery to meet our members' needs and expectations. This could not have been achieved without the active participation, strong support, constructive feedback and suggestions from all of you. For the past 25 years, we have built a strong camaraderie and friendships with our members and would like to express our sincerest appreciation and gratitude to everyone who has played a part in bringing OCC to where we are today.

As part of the Club's ongoing service improvement initiatives, you would have noticed that registration and payment processes have been automated at our Club facilities since 1 April 2018 (Sunday). With this automation of processes, members will no longer be required to manually sign in and out when utilising the Golf Changing Rooms, Aranda Lounge, Gymnasium, Swimming Pools and Orchid Bowl. Members patronizing F&B outlets such as Par Lounge, Himawari Japanese Restaurant, Peach Garden Chinese Restaurant, Royale Café, 100% Muslim-owned Royal Palm "Halal" Restaurant and Vanda Terrace can simply charge their consumption with a swipe of their membership card. This ensures that members' personal information are protected and also improve your overall service experiences. Should your membership card be found faulty at the point of registration or payment, you will be pleased to know that you can get a complimentary one-for-one replacement card, and our Club personnel will assist you in this simple process. Do remember to bring along your membership card for this seamless registration and payment convenience.

The highly anticipated upgrading of our Golf Registration Counter will be commencing on 10 May 2018 (Thursday) and renovation works are scheduled for completion by 26 June 2018 (Tuesday). During this interim, all Golf registrations will be temporarily shifted to the Octagon. Once completed, members can look forward to a tastefully refurbished "open concept" Golf Registration Counter with glass enclosure, air-conditioning and cosy Lounge areas, providing a bright and refreshing outlook and creating a complete and memorable service experience. We would like to thank you for your patience and understanding during the renovation period.

You will be delighted to know that we are continuing with our Club-wide energy conservation initiatives. In April 2018, you would have noticed the replacement of conventional lightings to LED light fixtures for the Level 2 corridors outside the Emerald Suite and Par Lounge at the Golf Clubhouse. We will gradually progress to the Social and Recreation Clubhouses for the next phase. This brightens up the Clubhouse and provides a safe environment, and a more cheerful and warm ambience. For other enhancement projects, the upgrading of Restrooms at the Golf Clubhouse Level 1 & 2, Golf Changing Rooms, Social Clubhouse Level 1 (next to the Theatrette) is targeted to commence from July to November 2018. Details shall be available in due course so do look out for updates in our Club announcements.

At the Golfing front, this year's OCC-Seletar Inter-Club Match was played at Seletar Country Club on 18 March 2018 (Sunday), where 120 golfers from both Clubs participated enthusiastically for this annual friendly game. Into its 9th season, the exciting game has whipped up good team spirits, with friendships and camaraderie further strengthened between the two Clubs. We hope that our members will continue to participate actively in future friendly games as we endeavour to build strong and lasting bonds with our neighbouring Clubs.

In other Club news, one of the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) new rulings on Jackpot Room operations will be put in place with effect from 1 May 2018 (Tuesday). All members are required by the National Council on Problem Gambling (NCPG) to sign a one-time consent form in order to verify whether there are any Self-Exclusion or NCPG Relevant Exclusion, and for NCPG to release such information to the Club. When registering for entry or re-entry into the Jackpot Room, you are required to produce a valid photo identification card with NRIC number and OCC membership card for us to check NCPG Self-Exclusion and Relevant Exclusion Status. We thank you for your kind cooperation and understanding in this matter.

These 25 years for the Club have been a delightful journey as we witnessed many past achievements and accolades, which include being awarded "Asia's Best Course in Singapore (Dendro-Vanda Course)" for the prestigious Asian Golf Awards; with persistent focus on comprehensive cultural practices to ensure that the maintenance of our Golf Courses are consistently upkept at a high standard of playability, aesthetics and a memorable experience for our members and guests alike. These are a testament to our standard of excellence as we continue to strive to become one of the top Golf Clubs in Singapore. ### IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

MHA New Rulings For Jackpot Room With Effect From 1<sup>st</sup> May 2018 (Tuesday)

In compliance with regulatory requirements, all Members entering the Jackpot Room must comply with the followings:

1 Sign a One-Time Consent Form

It is mandatory and required by the National Council On Problem Gambling (NCPG) to verify whether a member has a Self-Exclusion or NCPG Relevant Exclusion (third-party exclusion); and for NCPG to release such information to the Club.

- 2 Entry Registration Into OCC Jackpot Room
  - **Step 1** All Members are required to produce a valid photo identification card with NRIC Number for the Club to check NCPG Self-Exclusion and Relevant Exclusion Status; and
  - **Step 2** All Members must produce a valid OCC Membership Card for the Club to check validity of Active Membership Status.

Members who do not wish to sign the One-Time Consent Form or refuse to produce a valid photo identification with NRIC number will not be allowed to enter the Jackpot Room.

### A Chat with the Winners

### How did you feel when you emerged as Champion for the Gold Medal 2017?

- **Tommy (T) :** I was happy as it was an event that I have always wanted to win, and I felt that I played well that day, which makes me happier knowing my hard work paid off.
- Janis (J) : I was shocked and extremely happy! Honestly, I didn't expect to win as there were many other better players. I just tried my best and stayed focused.

### What is your winning formula to playing golf well?

- **T**: Be smart around the golf course and stay as calm as possible even after a bad shot.
- J: I play regularly, at least twice a week. Playing regularly, the constant challenges and friendly competitions between friends motivate me to improve and up my game. I also have a coach with me 24/7 my husband! Learning your own strengths and weaknesses also helps; for me I focus on my short game.

### Besides consistent practice, how do you prepare yourself mentally before a game?

- **T**: As I tend to lose focus easily, I will write some notes down before the game and consistently look at it. This keeps me calm and I will be able to focus better.
- **J**: I was not focusing on the competition. I told myself to just focus on my game and play the way I normally would. This way, there was no pressure or stress.

### Any advice/tips for aspiring golfers who wish to improve their knowledge and skills?

- **T**: Train hard and train smart. Also, try to spend lesser time at the Range and more time on the golf course as that is where you really get to practise and understand your golf game.
- J:Find a good group of friends, enjoy their company and friendship, which can spur you on to improve. That's how I started to pick up golf and enjoy playing it. When you enjoy the game, you will naturally make constant improvements.



### What Should You Use To Mark Your Golf Ball?

During a golf game, ball markers are used on the putting green to mark the position of a player's golf ball, making it easier to remember where the ball landed on the green. According to USGA Rule 20-1, ball markers should be placed directly behind the ball to mark out the position of a player's ball on the putting green before it is lifted, so that other players can continue to putt without any hindrance.

Typically, small, round and relatively flat objects, are considered appropriate for players to use as a ball marker. However, there are also other unorthodox alternatives that may be used by golfers.

### **Recommended Ball Markers**



Using a loose impediment

Scratching a line

Even though a golfer will not be penalised when using the above methods to mark a ball, it is considered poor golf etiquette, and you are strongly encouraged not to do so in order to ensure an enjoyable game for all golfers.

### **Pre-Round Putting Routine To Save You Strokes**

Putting is as much about judgement as it is about technique. Below is a simple pre-round warm-up routine that will assist you to firstly, check that you are hitting putts "squarely" (straight), and secondly, assist you in gaining judgement on the speed of the greens.

Follow this routine before hitting the first tee, and you will find that you can putt better on the first hole and more confidently for the rest of your round.



To start off, take three balls and find a "straight" putt to one of the holes on the practice green with a distance of about 0.9m.

Your first exercise is to hole 6 consecutive putts of this length. Once you have achieved this, you will be confident in starting your putts fairly well along a straight line.

Z Your second exercise will help you to get a better "feel" for the speed of the greens.



Take your three balls and place them at varying distances from the green's fringe.

Tip: Take note that you should be putting to a distance in the second exercise, instead of putting to a hole. This will facilitate your judgement on the speed of the greens.



Putt these balls so that they finish as close to the fringe as possible. It will be beneficial to practise this more than once. Repeat the exercise in the opposite direction. Your first putts may have been slightly up or downhill, or into the grain or down-grain, so putting in the opposite direction will aid you in your judgement on the course.

# Take a few minutes to try out the above routine, and you might just save yourself a few strokes during your golf games!


